

Seminar on “Neuro Rehabilitation”

A seminar on “Neuro Rehabilitation” was conducted by Indian Head Injury Foundation on 8th Feb. 2017 at their DCWA centre, Jamrudpur.

Ms. Christine Lefavre, OT, President Rainbow Rehabilitation, Prof. at University of British Columbia delivered a lecture on “Traumatic Brain Injury”. She shared the experiences of the patients and how their rehab has been done in the department as well as in their home environment. She laid emphasis on community rehabilitation of such patients to get best results and also focused on customized treatment protocols for each patient. She discussed the rainbow effect that describes Cognitive retraining based on pre-injury lifestyle and organic damage, management of inter-related stress symptoms and the unique theory of the traumatically induced dysfunctional family.

Dr Tarun Lala demonstrated few techniques of NDT in a paralytic patient.

The seminar was attended by 25 students along with Dr Charu Chopra and Dr Nidhi Kalra and it was a great learning experience.
