NOTICE REGARDING CHANGE IN NOMENCLATURE, ADMISSION CRITERIA AND OTHER DETAILS IN CERTAIN PARAMEDICAL COURSES IN ACCORDANCE WITH NATIONAL COMMISSION FOR ALLIED HEALTH CARE PROFESSION DURING THE ACADEMIC SESSION 2026-27.

This is in continuation to earlier Notification No. 05/2026, F.No. IPU-7/Academic/2026-27/2066 dated 23.03.2026 vide which it was informed that the Indraprastha University will not carry out admission in Bachelor of Physiotherapy (B.PT) and Bachelor of Occupational Therapy (B.OT) through the merit of NEET UG 2026.

As per the guidelines of National Commission for Allied Health Care Profession, the nomenclature, admission criteria, duration etc. is amended as below:
